All students will achieve a Student Growth Percentile score of 50% or higher for both ELA and math

At School

- Teachers will implement a culturally proficient curriculum by working to identify classroom instructional practices that promote high achievement for ALL students, and specifically Black and Latino boys
- Teachers will be explicit and intentional in their focus on student mastery of the academic language embedded in the Common Core Standards to address the achievement and opportunity gaps that exist between students of different races, ethnicities, and needs.
- Teachers will identify strategies and incentives that encourage students to use academic language on a daily basis in both classroom discussions and student conversations



At Home

- Students should be reading at home every single night!
- Encourage your child to use specific vocabulary when talking about math and reading
- Spend time together discussing topics your child is interested in learning more about. This will get your child excited about reading!
- Homework, homework, homework! Support your child and make sure they are in a quiet environment where they can focus

Sample Question to ask:

What did you learn in math class today? How does it connect to what you did in math yesterday?
