EDISON K8: Kindergarten Learning Goal

All students will make progress in reading and at least 90% of students will move up at least one category in each subtest



At School

- Teachers will use Foundations, a multi-sensory approach to teach students letter names and sounds.
- Teachers will provide families with parent resource packets from Foundations to support and extend the classroom learning environment at home
- Teachers will track student growth on assessments and will send monthly assessments home to keep families continually aware of their child's progress
- Teachers will plan and implement small intervention groups to practice letter naming, first sound fluency, phoneme segmentation fluency and nonsense word fluency



At Home

- Students should be reading at home every single night! Make it a family routine and read together every night before bed! Talk about books asking questions like, "Why do you think that?"
- Build vocabulary together! Encourage your child to use specific vocabulary when talking about what they did at school
- Use imagination! Make it a game and come up with fun stories together using objects from around the house

Who is your favorite character in the story? WHY?
