

Kindergarten Common Core: What Should I Be Able to Do?



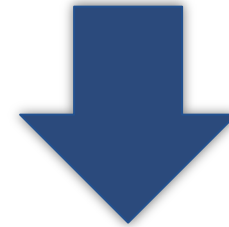
Reading

I can look at new words and figure them out by using what I know about letters and sounds



Math

I can count to 100 by ones and tens



Listening & Speaking

I can listen and take turns speaking when I am having conversations with my family, friends, and teachers

What can you do at home?

- Students should be reading at home every single night! Let your child struggle with new words and ask them to slowly them out slowly
- Count EVERYTHING! The number of people on the bus, socks going into the washing machine, plates at the dinner table...
- Talk to your child about school. Ask specific questions like, "What did you read in school today? Did you like the book? Why?"
